Smack each battery terminal with the heel of a shoe to rotate it slightly around the battery post if the car will not start. Then try starting the engine. Try: Smacking the starter. If you have access to the starter motor, try smacking it with the tire iron from your car jack. Sometimes, the electrical contacts get stuck and can be freed by tapping on them. Restricted Air-flow: An engine doesn't start because of restricted air-flow to the engine. This may be because of obstructions such as dry leaves in the front grill air vent or choked air-filter. Remove obstructions in the air intake ducts. Choked Air-filter. Remove the air filter element and clean / replace as recommended by the manufacturer.

A broken starter is another common reason your car won't start. A starter is an electrical motor that is connected to the battery. It's role is to set the engine (i.e. pistons, crankshaft, etc.) in motion when you turn the ignition switch on. Once the engine starts and is in motion, the starter's job is complete.

Another common problem when the car does not start is problems with the spark. It can be caused either by a bad spark plug, a bad ignition coil, or a bad ignition cable. The wiring could also cause problems at the ignition coil or no signal from the crankshaft sensor, so you should always diagnose the crankshaft sensor first.

Common reasons for this to happen: If the engine cranks, but the car doesn't start: Bad fuel pump: A faulty fuel pump won't deliver fuel to the engine, even if you've just filled up. Bad spark plugs: Without hot sparks to ignite the fuel charge in each cylinder, there is no combustion and no expansion of the burning mixture. Thus, the engine will not start.

If the engine still won't start, the most likely culprit is a lack of compression. Advance carries compression testers that thread into the spark-plug holes and read compression when you turn the engine over. After making sure the engine won't start when you crank it, remove one plug and thread the tester in the hole.

If there is plenty of gas but no spark, the engine will crank but not start. Unplug one of the spark plug wires and plug in a spark tester.
