Catastrophic Brain Injury Guidelines Consider obtaining a critical care consult if not already involved in patient care Maintain SBP >90 (MAP>60) 1. Consider invasive hemodynamic monitoring 2. Adequate hydration: Ensure adequate hydration to maintain euvolemia 3.

### **Catastrophic Brain Injury Guidelines**

Catastrophic defined for this purpose as brain injury that is expected to result in a non-survivable neurological injury as determined by Neurosurgery, Trauma or ICU services after

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appropriate diagnostic studies and clinical examination Purpose of the guidelines To support the patient in order to allow time for family to gather at the bedside

A patient who sustains catastrophic or devastating brain injuries requires intensive monitoring and treatment, typically in an intensive care setting. Recommended treatment guidelines include: Maintain systolic blood pressure (SBP) greater than 100 mmHg or mean arterial pressure greater than 60 mmHg. Treat Diabetes Insipidus to prevent intravascular fluid depletion.

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An organ procurement organization (OPO) and a level I trauma center developed catastrophic brain injury guidelines (CBIGs) to assist in the care of severely brain-injured adult patients before brain death. The CBIGs provided a set of clinical guidelines to maintain patient stability and optimize opportunity for organ donation.

## **Catastrophic Non-Survivable Brain Injury**

8 Catastrophic brain injury or disease. An injury or disease is a catastrophic brain injury or disease if the injury or disease results in an impairment of cognitive, physical or psychosocial functions and it results in: (a) one or more of the following: (i) a period of post traumatic amnesia of at least 7 days;

## **Military Rehabilitation and Compensation (Catastrophic**

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The more stringent thresholds for catastrophic impairment are seen in: the mental disorder criterion in comparison with current practice, the combining criterion in comparison with current practice, and the brain injury/impairment criterion by removing the GCS. Additionally, some of the criteria are more complex than the current.

## **Brain Injury/Impairment in the Catastrophic Impairment**

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A catastrophic injury is a severe injury to the spine, spinal cord, or brain, and may also include skull or spinal fractures. This is a subset of the definition for the legal term catastrophic injury, which is based on the definition used by the American Medical Association.

## **Management of perceived devastating brain injury after**

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Full supportive care is recommended for at least 72 hours from initial presentation to maximize the potential for recovery and minimize secondary injury.
