DOC files use a proprietary binary format and are used by Microsoft Word 2003 and earlier. DOCX files use a newer file format referred to as Open XML, which stores a document as a collection of separate files and folders in a compressed zip package. The DOCX extension is used by Microsoft Word 2007 and later.
